

South Park Business Group 2013 Walkabout Sidewalk & Vendor Form

Background: Walkabouts have become popular events, attracting thousands of visitors into South Park. These events were organized and created by South Park businesses, who pay to promote and produce them. We work hard to preserve the attractive neighborhood character of these events, and do not offer “exhibit space” to outsiders. The Walkabouts are not like some other street fairs – the idea is to get people into the shops and eateries, to browse and patronize South Park businesses.

South Park Business Group policy: Although it is against City zoning regulations to set up a cart or sell on a public sidewalk, SPBG recognizes that some member businesses wish to increase activity at their location by setting up sidewalk displays or inviting outside vendors. (We ask that you respect your neighboring businesses – please do not invite outsiders with merchandise that competes with their offerings.)

Procedure/Forms/Monitor: To protect against unauthorized vendors, a Walkabout Monitor will visit each sidewalk vendor to obtain proof that it has been authorized by a SPBG merchant. This form (below) should be completed in advance and signed by both the merchant and the exhibitor. The Monitor will ask the vendor for the authorization form. To avoid interruptions during your busy time, please be sure to give a signed form and instructions to your authorized vendor(s) before the Walkabout begins.
